



# Registration Form

The Registration Form must be completed and returned to the Registrar with the registration fee of £75 before a child may be considered for a place in the School. The registration fee is non refundable. On acceptance of a place, parents are required to pay a deposit of £1000, £500 of this shall be credited against the first term's invoice. For day and boarding pupils from overseas, a Deposit of £4000 is required. No further registration fee is required for transfer to other departments in the School i.e. Junior, Senior or Sixth Form. Parents are liable for School Fees when a place has been accepted and an Acceptance Form completed. **The deposit will be returned after the pupil leaves the School, but will be forfeited if the pupil does not join the School or does not give the required notice of withdrawal.**

## Admission Requirements

Registration Forms are accepted on the understanding that pupils will not be offered a place until they have passed Farringtons School's entry requirements.

**Foundation Stage:** All Pre-Reception and Reception applicants will be required to undertake an age appropriate assessment/taster session.

**Junior Department:** All Junior Department applicants will be required to spend a day in school with their year group and will be assessed in Literacy and Numeracy. External applicants must have a reference and/or report from their current school.

**Senior Department:** A Year 7 Entrance Examination is held in the Autumn Term prior to transfer. External applicants must have a reference and report from their current school and will be interviewed.

Year 8 – 10: Entrance papers must be taken for entry to any part of the Senior School, together with an interview. These papers are taken at Farringtons, but may, exceptionally, be taken at a pupil's current school with their agreement. A report and/or reference from an applicant's current school will be sought.

**Sixth Form:** Admission to particular courses will depend upon availability of places and a student's prior attainment at GCSE. Our policy is to ensure that students accepted into the Sixth Form can be placed in appropriate courses where they are likely to succeed. For this reason the following entry criteria is applicable to the courses offered. If an applicant does not meet the criteria, the school reserves the right to use its discretion, based on the school's knowledge of that applicant, to offer a place or suggest an alternative subject option.

- Students are required to have a minimum of 65 points to take four A Level subjects .
- Students are required to have a minimum of 55 points to take three A Level subjects.
- Students achieving less than 55 points are required to choose a mixture of BTEC and A Level programmes (this could be just one BTEC course).

(A\* = 8 points, A = 7 points, B = 6 points, C = 5 points, D = 4 points, E = 3 points)

A full copy of our Sixth Form Admissions Policy is available on request from the Registrar.

Overseas students are required to have Upper Intermediate Level (B2) English to join A Level courses. Students with Intermediate Level (B1) may be offered a three year A Level course.

**Entry from one Department to another within the School is not automatic. Pupils need to be able to demonstrate a satisfactory standard of academic ability and have an interview with the Headmistress or Senior Member of Staff.**
