### FARRINGTONS AND BYMT TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR MUSIC LESSONS

Licenced teachers are supplied through BYMT, not Farringtons School. The teacher will may store and share your data only with BYMT as the licencing body in accordance with GDPR guidance. Both Farringtons School and BYMT may contact you with relevant musical opportunities. Farringtons school will under no circumstances be involved in mitigating any of the conditions below as the agreement is solely between the payer and the BYMT teacher. Lessons:

- 1. BYMT reserves the right to provide your child with a different teacher due to unforeseen circumstances, such as a longer-term absence and will liaise with you accordingly.
- Your teacher will normally deliver 30 lesson per academic year (an average of 10 lesson per term). If you would like additional lessons, these may be arranged through agreement with the teacher at a pro rata lesson rate. Longer terms may have more lessons to keep the average at 10 lesson a term.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the *parent* to inform the teacher any circumstance such as of school trips, exam or assessment weeks where a lesson cannot take place, giving the relevant weeks' notice. Published lessons missed by the pupil where a parent has not given at least a weeks' notice will not be credited. No credit is given due to holiday taken in term time.
- 4. Should a lesson be cancelled due to circumstances beyond the control of the teacher, for example school closure due to snow, they will make all reasonable steps to make it up. However, there is no guarantee that this may be possible.
- 5. In the event of a school closure of more than two weeks, alternative arrangements can be made between the teacher and the payer to provide online tuition, reschedule lessons, or not to invoice.
- 6. Physical lessons must not take place in the teacher's or pupil's home under any circumstances.
- 7. If you wish to discontinue lessons, written notice must be given direct to the teacher (not to Farringtons School) by the last day before half term. Lessons will the charged until the end of term.
  - a. If notice is given at the start of a term, then you will be liable for the whole terms' fees.
  - b. If notice is given after the last day before half term, then you will be liable for the whole of the next terms' fees. (Autumn and Spring terms only)
  - c. If you give notice after the summer half term, you will only be charged the half term's fee in lieu of notice.
- Teachers reserve the right to discontinue lessons in circumstances such as non-payment of fees, pupils not attending lessons regularly or forgetting to bring their instrument regularly. BYMT will endeavour to provide you with tuition options if you contact them.
- 9. If the student uses photocopies of commercially available music, the payer takes on full liability for any copyright infringement, fines, or enforcement.

#### PAYMENTS

- 10. Fees will be reviewed annually, and invoices issued termly.
- 11. Fees are due in advance at the start of each term and must be made within 14 days of receiving an invoice. If payment is not received within this period, the teacher has the right to suspend further lessons until such times as they are received. Lessons missed though the late payment of fees will not be made up.
- 12. Teachers have the right to pursue all unpaid invoices, if necessary, though the courts.
- 13. Parents/ Carers must pay for all sheet music and external examination fees (upon agreement) and all accessories, such as strings, rosin, and reeds.
