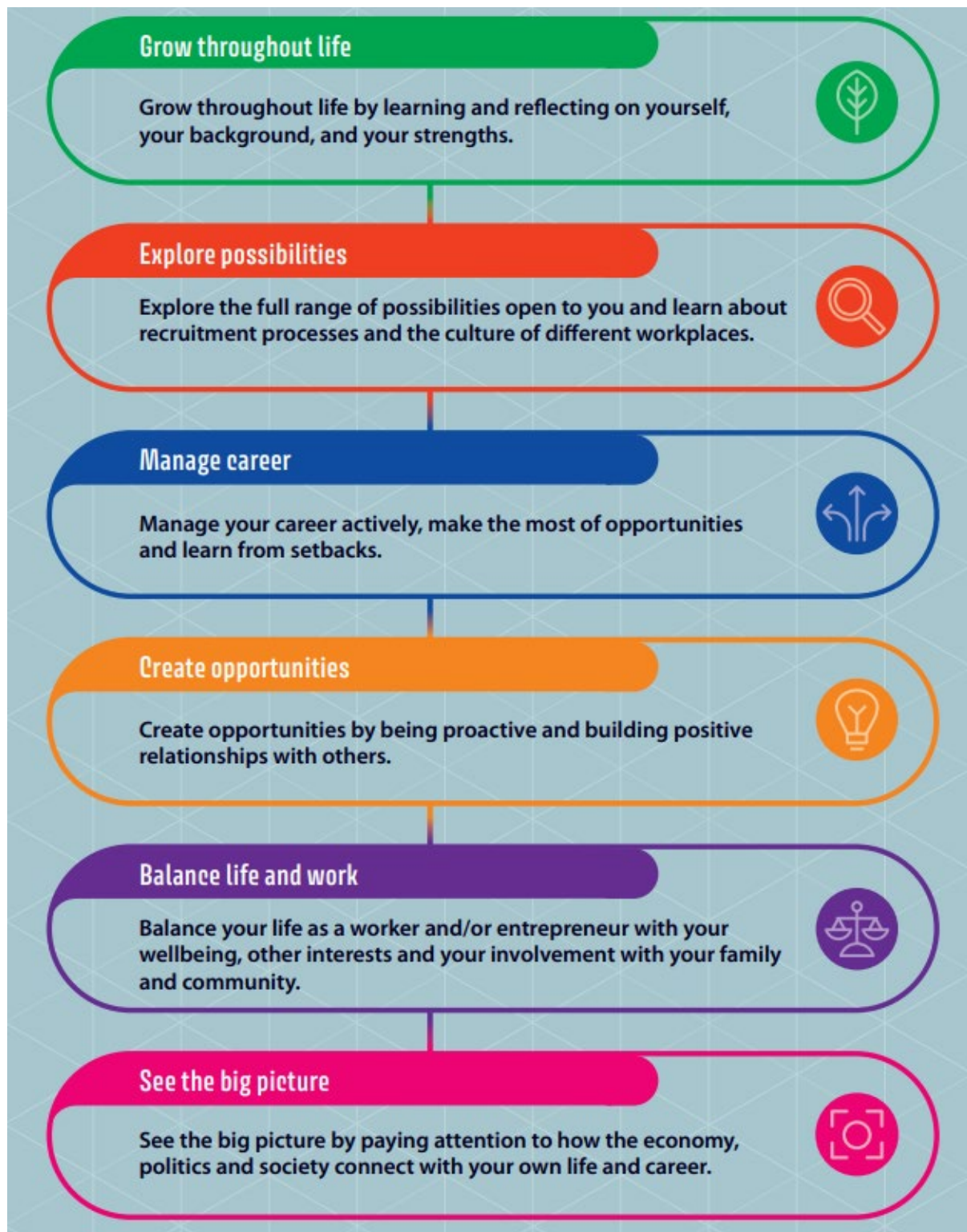
Farringtons Futures Careers Plan 2023-2024
